BAKU-IS THE CAPITAL OF AZERBAIJAN

Baku is a capital of the Republic of Azerbaijan. It is a large scientific, cultural and industrial center.

Ancient foundations, large area and population - all make Baku one of the oldest and largest cities in the East. Baku is situated on the shore of the Caspian Sea in the south of Absheron peninsula. It covers an area of 2,200 square km and has a population of 2,5 million.

The ancient city of Baku has numerous historical and architectural monuments dating to various historical epochs. The Old City of Icheri Sheher occupies 22 hectares in the center of Baku. It hosts over 50 historical and architectural monuments from various eras.

Azerbaijan's unique architectural monument – the Maiden Tower – is located in the south-western part of the Icheri Sheher. The tower was built in two stages. The Maiden Tower has a total height of 29.7 meters, with a diameter of 16.5 meters. The wall thickness in the bottom part is 5 meters, reducing to 4 meters at the top. The tower consists of 8 tiers and has a 21 meter deep water well.

Baku has been elected as the capital of Islamic culture for 2009. There are plenty of theatres, concert halls, cinemas and one circus in Baku. In spare time it would be of great interest to visit different museums, amateurs of art may go to exhibition halls. In the evening you may sit in various cafes and restaurants. Besides the national cuisine in fact all cuisines of the world are represented here.

One of the largest event in 20 years of karate in independent Azerbaijan was 39th European Cadet and Junior Karate championship, what was held in Baku Azerbaijan 10-12 February 2012.
